

1 **Subtitle C—Reports**

2 **SEC. 3131. NATIONAL ACADEMY OF SCIENCES REVIEW OF**
3 **NATIONAL SECURITY LABORATORIES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after the
5 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Energy
6 shall enter into an agreement with the National Academy
7 of Sciences to conduct a study of the following labora-
8 tories:

9 (1) The Lawrence Livermore National Labora-
10 tory, California.

11 (2) The Los Alamos National Laboratory, New
12 Mexico.

13 (3) The Sandia National Laboratories, Cali-
14 fornia and New Mexico.

15 (b) ELEMENTS.—The study required under sub-
16 section (a) shall include, with respect to each laboratory
17 specified in such subsection, an evaluation of the following:

18 (1) The quality of the scientific research being
19 conducted at the laboratory, including research with
20 respect to weapons science, nonproliferation, energy,
21 and basic science.

22 (2) The quality of the engineering being con-
23 ducted at the laboratory.

1 (3) The criteria used to assess the quality of
2 scientific research and engineering being conducted
3 at the laboratory.

4 (4) The relationship between the quality of the
5 science and engineering at the laboratory and the
6 contract for managing and operating the laboratory.

7 (5) The management of work conducted by the
8 laboratory for entities other than the Department of
9 Energy, including academic institutions and other
10 Federal agencies, and interactions between the lab-
11 oratory and such entities.

12 (c) COOPERATION.—The Secretary of Energy shall,
13 in consultation with the Secretary of Defense and the Di-
14 rector of National Intelligence, ensure that the National
15 Academy of Sciences receives full and timely cooperation
16 from the Department of Energy, the Department of De-
17 fense, and the intelligence community (as that term is de-
18 fined in section 3(4) of the National Security Act of 1947
19 (50 U.S.C. 401a(4))) in conducting the study required
20 under subsection (a).

21 (d) REPORT.—The National Academy of Sciences
22 shall submit to the Secretary of Energy a report con-
23 taining the results of the study and any recommendations
24 resulting from the study.

25 (e) SUBMITTAL TO CONGRESS.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than January 1,
2 2011, the Secretary of Energy shall submit to the
3 appropriate congressional committees the report sub-
4 mitted under subsection (d) and any comments or
5 recommendations of the Secretary with respect to
6 that report.

7 (2) FORM.—The report shall be submitted to
8 the appropriate congressional committees in unclas-
9 sified form, but may include a classified annex.

10 (f) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-
11 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-
12 sional committees” means the following:

13 (1) The Committee on Armed Services, the
14 Committee on Energy and Commerce, and the Com-
15 mittee on Science and Technology of the House of
16 Representatives.

17 (2) The Committee on Armed Services and the
18 Committee on Energy and Natural Resources of the
19 Senate.

20 **SEC. 3132. PLAN TO ENSURE CAPABILITY TO MONITOR,**
21 **ANALYZE, AND EVALUATE FOREIGN NU-**
22 **CLEAR WEAPONS ACTIVITIES.**

23 (a) PLAN.—The Secretary of Energy, in consultation
24 with the Director of National Intelligence and the Sec-
25 retary of Defense, shall prepare a plan to ensure that the
