A. Cut UC execs making more than \$200k to fund research and education

★ SAVINGS FROM CUTTING UC EXEC PAY

average pay execs making over \$200,000	\$305,000
number in the "over \$200,000 club"	x 400
payroll for "over \$200,000 club"	\$122,000,000

20% pay cut	SAVINGS = \$24,400,000
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50% pay cut	SAVINGS = \$61,000,000
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★ WHERE COULD THESE SAVINGS GO?

Amount needed to bring 3,800 UPTE-CWA researchers and techs up to a "family sustaining wage"	COST = \$21,600,000
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According to a UC press release dated 1/14/09, amount of state funding required for 1 year of undergraduate education for 1 student	\$11,073
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Fewer freshman during 2009-2010 due to January 2009 enrollment curtailment	x 2300
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Restoring student enrollments	COST = \$25,467,273
